NOTICE OF VACANCY

The Sunshine Water Control District Board of Supervisors gives notice of a vacancy on the Board of Supervisors. The vacancy is due to the resignation of the person elected to the position, effective February 11, 2026. The Board intends to appoint a replacement at its February 11, 2026 meeting. The selected appointee will complete the remainder of the four-year term for Seat 1, ending in November 2028.

Sunshine Water Control District is an independent special district created under Chapter 298, Florida Statutes. The Board meets on the second Wednesday of each month at 4:00 p.m. Supervisors must be at least 18 years of age, a U.S. citizen, a permanent resident of the state, and a resident of the District. See District boundaries below.

At that time, applicants will have an opportunity to address the Board and the audience, as well as giving the Board the opportunity to ask questions of the applicants.

District boundaries:

The District's northern boundary is Wiles Road. The west border of the District is the Sawgrass Expressway along the L-36 Canal. The southern boundary of the District is Canal Z, located on the south side of Royal Palm Boulevard. Sunshine's Canal A, located along the east border of the Dells neighborhood, forms the District's eastern border from Wiles Road to Sample Road. The remaining eastern border of the District from Sample Road to Royal Palm Boulevard is the City of Coral Springs/City of Margate municipal boundary.
