Re: **RESPONSE REQUESTED by December 1, 2017** – West Outfall Canal Construction Project (WOFC)

The Sunshine Water Control District (SWCD) is continuing implementation of our Capital Improvement Plan, taking proactive steps to improve overall canal infrastructure in a fiscally responsible way. In 2018, SWCD will embark on a project to widen and deepen the West Outfall Canal (WOFC), the canal behind your home. The WOFC Project is necessary to improve stormwater management and flood protection. We have included important information in this communication that we believe will give you an understanding of the WOFC Project and your options as a potentially impacted property owner.

Please be advised that encroachments (trees, shrubs, decks, auxiliary structures, etc.) within SWCD right-of-way must be moved/removed as part of this project. However, items will not be moved/removed for several months. In the coming days, SWCD representatives will be knocking on your door to provide an explanation of the project and your options. We are communicating well in advance to attempt to minimize any impact to property owners.

We ask that you carefully review the enclosed documents:

- **Encroachment Election Form** (please complete and return the Encroachment Election Form to SWCD in the enclosed envelope no later than December 1, 2017.)
